MajorSearch is a guide for students exploring majors or changing academic directions. Please follow the steps below to help you explore your options before talking with an academic adviser in DUS:

- Take the following steps to identify two or more possible majors:
  1. If you need help identifying areas of interest, complete a couple of [Interest Surveys](#)
  2. Also investigate [Explore Majors by Interest Area](#)
    - ✓ Click on the names of the majors that interest you and the [Bulletin](#) descriptions that go along with them. For each, ask yourself, "Am I interested in the topics this major addresses?"
    - ✓ Continue across the chart to [Recommended Academic Plans](#). Do you think you will enjoy and do well in the courses the major requires?
    - ✓ Can you appropriately complete [Entrance-to-Major Requirements](#) for your majors of interest?
