Writing/Speaking Skills (GWS) 9 credits

ENGL 015, 015A, 015S, or 030

[ESL 015](#) meets this requirement for non-native English speakers

CAS 100 * [A](#) / [B](#) / [C](#)

ENGL 202 * [A](#) / [B](#) / [C](#) / [D](#)

May be specified by college/major

* [EM SC 100S](#) may be an alternative to CAS 100 or ENGL 202 but does not meet GWS requirements in all majors.

Quantification (GQ) 6 credits

Natural Sciences (GN) 9 credits

Arts (GA) 6 credits

Humanities (GH) 6 credits

Social and Behavioral Sciences (GS) 6 credits

Health and Physical Activity (GHA) 3 credits

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

United States Cultures (US) 3 credits

May double count to meet General Ed, major, [BA requirement](#), or as an elective.

First-Year Seminar 1-3 credits

International Cultures (IL) 3 credits

May double count to meet General Ed, major, [BA requirement](#) (except [Other Cultures](#)), or as an elective. Study abroad courses typically satisfy this requirement.

Writing Intensive Course (W suffix) 3 credits

Typically embedded in courses required for a major.
